 - Intake, referrals, calendar, basic visualization/reporting

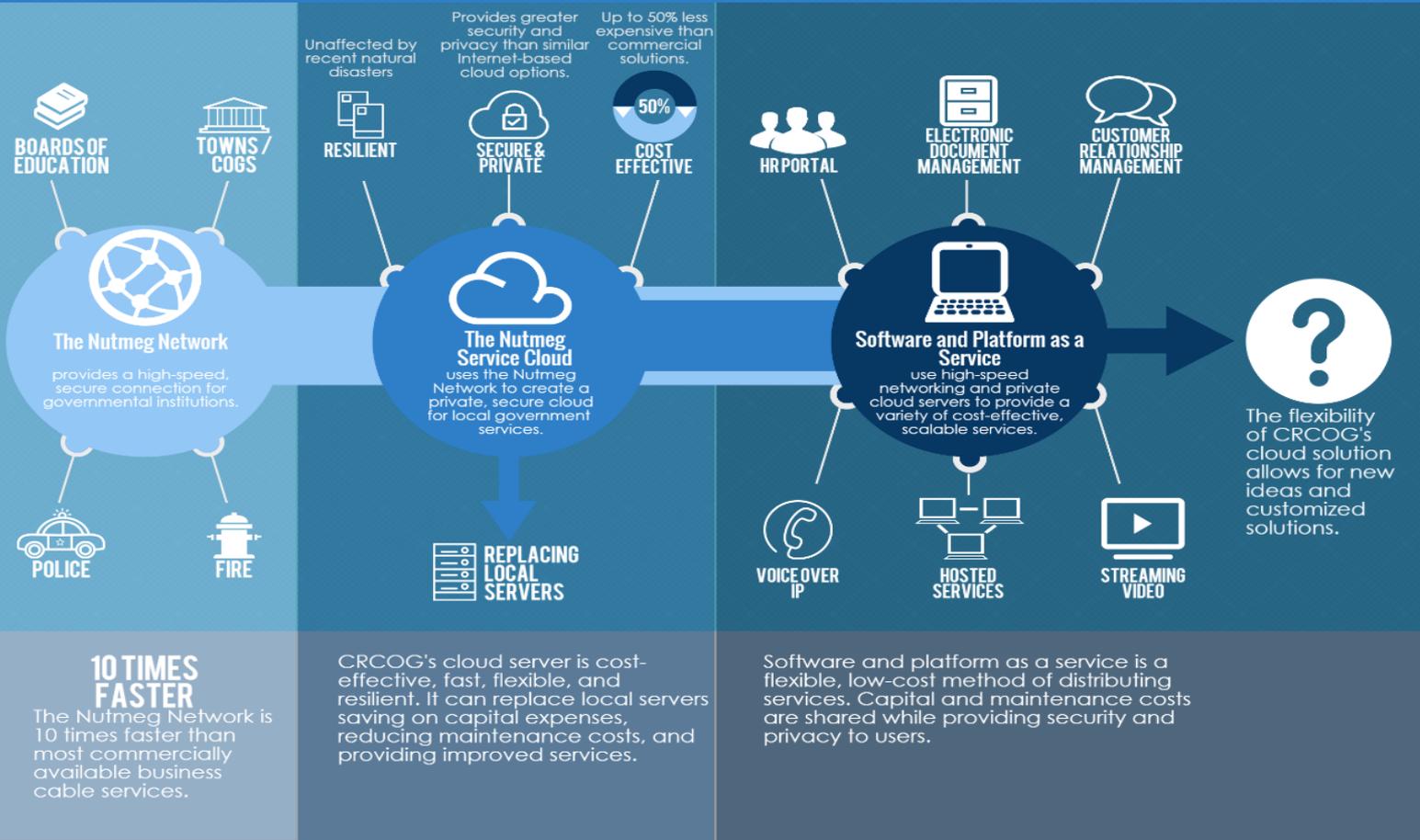
